Primary Responsibilities:

The employee in this class is responsible for picking up all trash, recyclable material, and all other debris in the City of Edmundson streets, sidewalks, public grounds to include the City of Edmundson Park and City owned properties.

Essential Duties, Responsibilities and Minimum Qualifications:

- Operate various City owned equipment: broom, shovel, weed eater, blower, etc.

- Must be able to pass background check, drug and physical exam
